Mahesha who completed his tenure and was relieved of his duties as Associate Dean (PG&R) were also appreciated and placed on record.

The Chairman welcomed the new member Dr. Jagannath Nayak who has taken charge as Associate Dean (PG & Research) and the two new student members to the Senate. The Chairman informed the members about the success of Golden Jubilee Celebrations and release of strategic plan of the Institute. He also informed that NIT Goa, being mentored by NITK Surathkal, has started its academic activities from July 2010. DASA admissions for 2010-11 were coordinated by NITK Surathkal and completed the admission process successfully. The notification for DASA 2011-12 was recently launched with modifications such as a requirement of minimum SAT score of 1800, revised fee of US\$ 7000 per annum etc. It is also proposed to offer PG admission (M. Tech, MBA) from the academic year 2011-12 under DASA. An inter NIT Committee has been constituted to suggest the detailed eligibility criteria, fee structure and other requirements for M. Tech and MBA programmes under DASA. The members were informed that this year the M. Tech admissions were carried out by centralized online process coordinated by NIT, Trichy and were completed successfully.
